Exactly who Hugh's father was is unknown; however, it's suspected that he may have been either Francis or Conel McGuire, based on the 1834 Tithe Applotment for the townland, which showed a Frances McGuire in a sub-denomination of Tullyhonwar in the larger Kilrean townland.² In 1830, Tullyhonwar became its own townland when the ordnance survey standardized townland boundaries and names.³ At that time Clonconwall became its own townland also, surveyed off the larger Kilrean.

At present it's not possible to tell which man was the father of Hugh McGuire, because where Hugh's property was situated in Kilrean Upper townland is between Clonconwall and Tullyhonwar.

Kilrean Upper Townland was the property of the Reverend George N. Tredennick in 1857 and thus the landlord for the McGuire family.⁴

Child, born in Ireland:

- i. HUGH² MCGUIRE, b. 1803; m. Mary Malloy.

HUGH² MCGUIRE (—¹) was born 1803 most likely in the townland of Kilrean, Killybegs Lower Parish, County Donegal, Ireland, and died 10 May 1883 in Kilrean Upper. His death certificate showed that he was an eighty-year-old widower when he died in "Kilrairie" of old age (six weeks with no medical attendant). He had been a farmer. The informant was Rose Maguire, his daughter-in-law, who was present at the time of his death.⁵

He married MARY MALLOY about 1845 (based on the birth of their first child), likely in Glenties Catholic Parish, County Donegal, although the records do not go back far enough to document this. She

was born about 1824 and died before 1881 in the townland of Kilrean Upper, Killybegs Lower Parish, County Donegal, Ireland.

In 1855, Hugh rented Lot #28 in Kilrean Upper from the Rev. Tredennick.⁶ The land consisted of twenty-four acres, two roods, and twenty perches. Acres, roods, and perches are “English” acres, not “Irish” acres (which was a measurement up until the early 1830s).⁷ Hugh remained the responsible party for paying the taxes until his daughter-in-law Rosa took over the house and acreage, about 1886.⁸

Children of Hugh and Mary (Malloy) McGuire, all born in Ireland:

- i. ANNE “NELL”⁹ MCGUIRE, b. about 1846 most likely in Kilrean Upper; d. 11 November 1912 in Kilrean Upper, at the age of seventy-eight of “probable senility.” She had been ill for three months. She was a spinster and housekeeper. Her death was uncertified with no medical attendant. The informant was her nephew, Denis McGuire.⁹

Anne may have been born a twin with sister Maggie McGuire, according to family records.

In 1901, Anne was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper, residing with her sister-in-law, Rose McGuire. She was fifty-five, born in County Donegal. She was a knitter and a member of the Catholic Church.¹⁰

In 1911, Anne was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper, residing with her sister-in-law, Rose McGuire. She was seventy-four, born in County Donegal. She was a member of the Catholic Church and was unable to read.¹¹
- ii. MAGGIE MCGUIRE, b. about 1846 probably in Kilrean Upper; d. as a child.

Maggie may have been a twin to Anne, according to family records.
- iii. PATRICK MCGUIRE, b. about 1849 most likely in Kilrean Upper, and died before 1886 in Kilrean Upper;¹² m. ROSA CANNON 13 January 1874¹³ in Kilrean Upper, Glenties Roman Catholic Parish, County Donegal, daughter of Dennis Cannon.¹⁴ She was born 1841 in County Donegal.

In about 1886, Rose took over the responsibility for paying the tax on her in-laws twenty-four acres, two roods, and twenty perches.¹⁵

In 1901, Rose was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper. She was sixty, born in County Donegal. She was a widow, farmer, member of the Catholic Church, and could read. She signed her name with an "X" on the census form. Those listed were Rose (head, sixty), Mary Anne (daughter, twenty-two), Denis (son, twenty), and Anne (sister, fifty-five). The house was a private dwelling and there were two outbuildings on the property. There were two rooms with two windows in front.¹⁶

In 1911, Rose was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper. She was a member of the Catholic Church and was unable to read. She was the mother of three children born alive, of which only two were still living. Those listed were: Rose Maguire (head, seventy-three), Denis (son, thirty-two), Mary A. (daughter, thirty-four), and Ann (sister-in-law, seventy-five).¹⁷

On 20 July 1911, Rose officially received title to her Kilrean farmland, which was listed as eighteen acres, two roods and thirty-nine perches.¹⁸ At this time the lot was renumbered 28Aa.¹⁹ In about 1928, the ownership went to her son Denis McGuire.²⁰

Children of Patrick and Rose (Cannon) McGuire, born in Ireland:

- 1 MARIA ANNA⁴ MCGUIRE, b. 18 November 1876 in Kilrean Upper.²¹

On 18 November 1876, Maria was christened. Joanna McDyer and Anna McGill were listed as the sponsors.²²

In 1901, Maria was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper, residing with her mother. She was twenty-two, born in county Donegal. She was a knitter, member of the Catholic Church and could read and write.²³

In 1911, Maria was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper, residing with her mother. She was thirty-four, born in County Donegal. She was a member of the Catholic Church.²⁴

On 20 April 1879, Dennis was christened. Eugene Cannon and Catherine Doogan were the sponsors.²⁶

In 1901, Dennis was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper, residing with his mother. He was twenty, born in County Donegal. He was a farmer, member of the Catholic Church, and could read and write.²⁷

On 26 March 1908, Dennis, as a resident of Kilrean, witnessed a deed transaction between fellow Kilrean resident, John Hegarty, and the Congested District Board of Ireland, based at 23 Rutland Square in Dublin.²⁸

In 1911, Dennis was enumerated in the Ireland census of Kilrean Upper, residing with his mother. He was thirty-two, born in County Donegal. He was a member of the Catholic Church.²⁹

It was Dennis who took over the old family home and properties in Kilrean Upper in 1928.³⁰

iv. **HUGH MCGUIRE**, b. September 1854; m. **MARGARET L. ROGERS**.

HUGH³ MCGUIRE (*Hugh²*, —¹) was born September 1854³¹ in Kilrean Upper;³² d. 13 March 1924, in Richmond City, Henrico County, Virginia, at the age of sixty-eight and was buried in Lot 25, Section 6, in Mount Calvary Cemetery in Richmond, Virginia.³³

He married **MARGARET L. ROGERS** in Greensboro, Guilford County, North Carolina, on 11 December 1881,³⁴ daughter of John L. Rogers and Susan M. Richardson. She was born November 1865³⁵ in Franklin County, Virginia, according to the death record of her son Hugh E. McGuire.³⁶ Margaret died 25 December 1944 in Richmond City, Henrico County, Virginia, and was buried in Lot 25, Section 6, in Mount Calvary Cemetery in Richmond, Virginia.³⁷

During 1871, Hugh immigrated to the United States from Ireland, according to the 1910 federal census of Richmond, Virginia.³⁸ But the 1900 federal census of Richmond shows he immigrated in 1875.³⁹ The 1920 federal census gives his immigration as 1876 and that he was naturalized in 1877.⁴⁰

In 1880 Hugh was enumerated in the federal census of Rockingham County, North Carolina. He was residing with the family of Fillis Lowe and her children. Fillis was a black woman who was a cook for a living, and Hugh was a farmer. Hugh was twenty-nine years old, born in Ireland to Ireland-born parents and was single. Children, born to Fillis Lowe, in North Carolina were Robert Lowe (ten), John Lowe (seven), and Ida Lowe (one).⁴¹

When Hugh married Margaret Rogers in 1881 at Greensboro, Gilmore Township, Guilford County, North Carolina, he was thirty, the son of Hugh and Mary McGuire. His father was living in Ireland and his mother was deceased. He was a resident of Rockingham County. Margaret was nineteen, the daughter of John L. and Susan Rogers. Her father was deceased and her mother was living in Rockingham County. The Reverend Patrick Moore performed the marriage ceremony, which was witnessed by J. M. Douglass and M. McMahon both of Greensboro.⁴²

In 1900, Hugh and Margaret were enumerated in the federal census of Richmond, renting at 620 Louisiana Street. He was forty-five years old, born September 1854 in Ireland to Ireland-born parents, and a day laborer. Margaret was thirty-four, born November 1865 in Virginia, to Ireland-born parents. Their children, born in North Carolina, were Anna (b. November 1884, sixteen), and Margaret (b. June 1884, fifteen). Their other children, born in Virginia, were Hugh (b. June 1887, twelve), Theresa (b. January 1888, eleven), Nellie (b. January 1893, seven), Patrick (b. June 1895, four), and McKeefee (b. October 1898, one).⁴³

On 1 May 1909, Hugh McGuire purchased for \$5,750 land from B.C. and N. Kate Bristow. The land was described as "the lot at the northwestern intersection of Grace and 24th Street, fronting on the north line of Grace Street twenty-five feet intersecting back between parallel lines (one of which is the western line of 24th Street) one hundred and fifty feet to an alley in common twenty feet wide. Being the same property conveyed to N. Kate Bristow by deed from — Pollard, dated 9 January 1908." Recorded 4 May 1909.⁴⁴

On 1 May 1909, Hugh McGuire mortgaged the lot, just purchased from B.C. and N. Kate Bristow, to H.R. Pollard for \$4,410. Witnessed by H. E. McGuire and recorded 4 May 1909.⁴⁵

In 1910, Hugh and Margaret were enumerated in the federal census of Richmond, residing at 2316 E. Grace Street. Hugh was fifty-six years old, born in Ireland to Ireland-born parents. He labored as a watchman at a chemical company. Margaret was forty-three, born in Virginia to an Ireland-born father and a Virginia-born mother. The family could read and write. Other household members were Annie C. McNamara (twenty-six, b. in North Carolina), Margaret L. (twenty-four, b. in North Carolina), Hugh E.

(twenty-three, b. in North Carolina), Mary T. (twenty, b. in Virginia), Nellie L. (sixteen, b. in Virginia), Patrick C. (thirteen, b. in Virginia), Francis M. (eleven, b. in Virginia), Kathern C. (four, b. in Virginia), and Michael J. McNamara (son-in-law, thirty-four, b. in Virginia to Ireland-born parents).⁴⁶

On 10 June 1912, Hugh McGuire and Margaret McGuire, his wife, mortgaged for \$890.80 to H.R. Pollard the following property: "All that lot of land with improvements at the northwest corner of Grace and 24th Streets, fronting on the north line of Grace Street twenty-five feet, thence back northwardly between parallel lines (one of which is the west line of 24th Street) one hundred and fifty feet to an alley in common twenty feet wide." Recorded 27 June 1912.⁴⁷

On 5 June 1914, Hugh McGuire and Margaret McGuire, his wife, mortgaged for \$2,060 to H.R. Pollard, Trustee, "all that lot of land with the brick dwelling situated on the northwest corner of Grace and 24th Streets, fronting on the north line of Grace Street twenty-five feet, thence back northwardly between parallel lines (one of which is the west line of 24th Street) one hundred and fifty feet to an alley in common twenty feet wide." Recorded 16 June 1914.⁴⁸

On 29 September 1919, Hugh wrote his will. He directed his property be given to his wife, Margaret L. McGuire, and to his daughter, Katharine Charlotte McGuire. Also mentioned were daughters Annie C. McNamara, Marguerite Wallace, Mary Theresa McCabe, and Nellie Lee Richardson. Sons were Hugh E. McGuire, Patrick E. McGuire, and Francis M. McGuire. His wife was appointed executrix. The will was proved 7 April 1924.⁴⁹

In 1920, Hugh and Margaret were enumerated in the federal census of Richmond, residing at 2316 E. Grace Street. Hugh was sixty-five years old, born in Ireland to Ireland-born parents. Margaret was fifty-one, born in Virginia to Virginia-born parents. Their children, born in Virginia, were Patrick C. (twenty-two), and Katherine C. (fourteen), and three male lodgers, aged thirty-seven, forty-two, and thirty-two. One of the lodgers was Anthony Turbay, a Catholic Priest, who was forty-two and born in Syria.⁵⁰

On 14 March 1924, Hugh's death notice was published in the *Richmond News Leader*. He died at his residence, 2316 East Grace Street, Friday, March 14th at 10 A.M.⁵¹

On 15 March 1924, Hugh's obituary was published in the *Richmond Times-Dispatch*. He died at his residence at 2316 East Grace Street on Friday, March 14. His funeral was held Sunday afternoon at 3:00 o'clock in St. Patrick's Church. He was survived by his wife and seven children: Mrs. M.J. McNamara, Mrs. James M. McCabe, Mrs. John G. Richardson, Miss Katherine C. McGuire, Hugh E., Patrick C. and Francis K. McGuire.⁵²

On 15 March 1924, Hugh's obituary was published in the *News Leader*. He died at his residence, 2316 East Grace Street "yesterday morning." His funeral was conducted at 3:00 o'clock from St. Patrick's Church, with interment in Mt. Calvary. He leaves his wife and seven children Mrs. John G. Richardson, Mrs. M.J. McNamara, Mrs. James M. McCabe, Miss Katherine C. McGuire, Hugh E., Patrick C. and Francis K. McGuire.⁵³

In 1930, Margaret was enumerated in the federal census of Richmond, residing at 2316 E. Grace Street. She was sixty-three, born in Virginia to an Ireland-born father and a Virginia-born mother. This census indicated she owned her home. Her son-in-law and daughter were renting a portion of her home. Those listed were Margaret McGuire (head, sixty-three), Patrick C. (son, thirty-two), and Katherine C. (daughter, twenty-two). The McNamara family consisted of Michael (head, fifty-four), Annie (wife, forty-seven), and Donald J. (son, twelve).⁵⁴

On 26 December 1944, Margaret's obituary was published in the *Richmond News Leader* and the *Richmond Times-Dispatch*. She was the widow of Hugh McGuire, of 3419 Wythe Avenue. She died on a Monday at a local hospital. The funeral was held at 10 A.M. Wednesday at St. Patrick's Catholic Church. The burial was at Mount Calvary Cemetery. She was survived by four daughters: Mrs. M.J. McNamara, Mrs. J.M. McCabe, Mrs. J.G. Richardson, and Mrs. R.P. Dollard; and two sons: Patrick C. and Frances K. McGuire, all of Richmond.⁵⁵
